

CHILD PROTECTION IN EMERGENCIES (CPIE): CP AOR AS A PIONEER IN GOVERNMENT STRENGTHENING

WHAT

In collaboration with relevant partners, the Child Protection Area of Responsibility (CP AoR) has successfully engaged a total of 24 governments from the Western and Central Africa Region (WCAR) and the Eastern and Southern Africa Region (ESAR)




WHY

The capacity of 114 government representatives (97 from WCAR and 17 from ESAR) has been strongly enhanced so that national systems are better prepared and coordinated to protect children in emergencies



HOW

Between 2015 and March 2019, the CP AoR and its partners piloted and conducted 2 regional trainings and 4 workshops to strengthen the role of governments in CPIE



WITH WHOM

The CP AoR achieved impressive results thanks to the unique partnership with the International Federation of Red Cross and Red Crescent Societies (IFRC) and the Global Partnership to End Violence against Children, as well as to the support of UNICEF Humanitarian Partnerships team and Regional Offices



WHAT'S NEXT?

In 2020, the CP AoR will be actively engaging 11 governments from the Latin America and Caribbean Region (LACR) and the East Asia and Pacific Region (EAPR) to strengthen their leadership role in CPIE
